
President's Message:

WE NEED YOUR HELP !!!

Now that we're back to almost our "new normal" we'd like to call on our membership one more time. All of our activities are back at the Latcham Centre thanks to volunteer leaders. These members keep you healthy, having fun and in touch with others. The one thing we found out that was so very important during our Covid time of two years, was that fellowship with others mattered!

Now that we're in full swing with our activities we have also started thinking about social events in the future. We're already working on an outdoor Picnic in May and fortunately have volunteers for that committee.

Here are some examples of what we need volunteers for:

June B.B.Q. We need a person to shop for supplies. We have a list in the office to guide you as to our needs. We need someone to make up and print tickets. We need members to offer to help on the day of the BBQ, either on the BBQ's, in the kitchen or serving and selling tickets. Also if any member has a BBQ that can be moved we need a couple of them for our June BBQ. Gord Emmerson will be in charge of BBQ's.

December Dinner/Dance: We need someone to apply to the Township for a grant to help pay for the rental costs of the room in the Reach Street Complex. A member to contact the Caterer and also someone to set up the entertainment and bar person. **The previous 4 items need to be put in place ASAP.** There is a file in the office that can give you all the information from previous years and you can choose to use that information if you wish.

I hesitate to say "**photographer**", as we need someone who can take photos with either a cell phone or tablet in order that they can be emailed to our Newsletter Editor for inclusion into our monthly editions. This person would be left on their own to decide when and where to take club photos. Each member signs a waiver giving us (the Club) permission to take their photographs and put them in our newsletter or on our social media. Members do this when they're applying for membership.

Our Fall/Xmas Bazaar is a big commitment for us as it takes numerous members to fill our needs and the Bazaar is our only money maker of the year. We need an overall Chair and sub-chairs for the different events that make our day successful such as; serving lunch, deciding what you wish as a menu, getting volunteers to shop, set up tables and chairs, act as servers for the lunch/tea. In the past we've had a basket raffle. These baskets are filled with items that local merchants donate to us. However, it's up to the Sub-Chair to decide what they'd like to do to raise money for the Club. We need a Sub-Chair to organize the baking portion of our Bazaar. This is always a great success. Members will volunteer to bake goodies of all kinds and the Sub-Chair and her/his committee members agree on how to display the baked items and price them.

Crafts have always been a large portion of our bazaar also. The Sub-Chair needs to get together with her committee and decide what they feel would be good sellers and how to get them made by members.

The last few years we've had **a toonie table**, well actually toonie tables. These are not filled with junk, but with items that someone else will pay a toonie (or a few toonies) to purchase. Example: a clock that you no longer want but works. Xmas coffee mugs that you've had in the cupboard but never use.

You can volunteer to be the Sub-Chair of this part of the bazaar or volunteer to be a committee member.

As I said, the Bazaar is a very big project and our only money maker, but when there are members to fill in on the different committees it's a lot of small projects put together. You get to meet and work with other members and we have fun.

We'll put a member of the Executive on the Bazaar Committee so that when the Chair and Sub-Chairs have meetings the Exec member can answer any questions that may arise and they can also report back to the executive on how things are moving along.

A member is needed to get **speakers for general meetings and/or to set up a Bingo Committee** in order that some months next year we have bingo instead of a speaker. Meetings are held once a month and we don't have general meeting in July and August.

We also need people to help set up for the pot luck dinners and lunches- setting the tables, organizing the food as it comes in, making tea and coffee, etc. This works best with three or four people. Members of the Executive can get you started on this, as we have all had turns and know where stuff is kept.
