We have most of our furniture ordered, shipped and assembled with the proceeds from the grant.



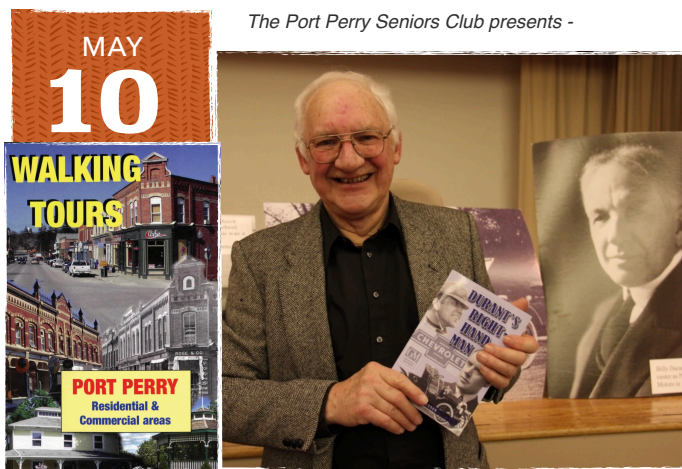
Bylaw Editing
