

Flu shots are available in Port. Regular and enhanced. Make your appointment.

2 to 64 years old

- doctor or nurse practitioner
- •some local public health units
- participating pharmacies

If you're **65 and older**, there are three different flu shots available:

- •The standard-dose vaccine protects against four strains of flu virus
- •The adjuvanted vaccine protects against three strains of flu virus and contains an adjuvant (a substance added to a vaccine that helps the recipient develop an improved immune response).
- The high-dose vaccine, (also called "Fluzone® HighDose Quadrivalent") protects against four strains of flu virus, but in higher doses.

All three flu vaccines are safe, effective and offer strong protection to seniors. Talk to your doctor, nurse practitioner, pharmacist or public health unit about which option is best for you. To get any of the standard dose, the adjuvanted or the high dose:

- visit a doctor or nurse practitioner
- contact your <u>local public health unit</u>
- visit a participating pharmacy
